# JUNIOR COMPETITION SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 97/98 season was once again a great season for all players, officials and parents involved. It was a season where the experienced sides were again dominant, but were pushed to the limits on most occasions with upsets occurring quite regularly. In general the season was dominated by batsmen, with at least one batting record being broken in all age groups except the Under 11's. I will never forget the smashing world record 368 not out by Adam McMillan in the Under 12's, the unbeaten 229 by Tim Ball in the Under 14's and the domination shown by Dean Badger, Jarryd Gordon and Jeffery Baker when setting new Association records.

The Under 15/16 competition was again a success as we had 13 teams competing which enabled us to have two Divisions.

We were just short of having split Divisions in the Under 12's and Under 14's. Eventually it is hoped that we will have two split divisions in all age groups.

To the Clubs which are involved in the "Have A Go" cricket programme, I commend you on your foresight. Your tremendous commitment to your Club and Cricket in general will see some big rewards in the future. These programmes ensure the long term viability of your Clubs.

This season saw a large increase in overall numbers. This was due to the Under 16 Comp., the influence of Have A Go Programmes and we had three new Clubs join the Association. We had 751 registered players at the end of the season compared to 680 players the previous season. The number of teams also increased from 50 to 57 teams. With the Ashes Tour due next season, it is expected that we will see another dramatic increase.

Congratulations to all the Premiers, you can now sit back and enjoy the fruits of your season's efforts.

Special congratulations to Rooty Hill R.S.L. who have once again defied the odds to take out the Junior Club Championship for a record fourth year in a row!

I would like to give a very special thank you to all Clubs who have supported me this year. You have made the job that much easier. Your tireless work is too often overlooked by those who just turn up, play their game, and go home.

On the Rep. scene we enjoyed a remarkably improved season in the Shell Shield. We managed ten wins and a tie, compared to five wins the previous year. Our Cawsey Shield (U/12) were unluckily beaten in the Semi after winning their Division with four wins. Thank you to all Players, Coaches, Managers, Scorers, Officials and Supporters for all your boundless efforts.

Congratulations to Dave McMillan who was named Rep. Coach of the year and Adam McMillan, Adam Lovett, Brenton McFadgean and Andrew Grieve, who could not be split for the Rep. Player of the Year Award. Special mention to Andrew Grieve who took out the Weblin Shield Bowling Award.

A special thank you must go to our Sponsors: Just Cricket, Alabout Glass & Glazing, J.A.W. Trophies and Sports, Blacktown R.S.L. and Rooty Hill R.S.L. Without their support we would find it difficult to even field Rep. teams. We will be endeavouring to get increased sponsorships next season to try and decrease the Rep. Fees.

## BLACKTOWN CITY & DISTRICT CRICKET UMPIRES ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED

Season 1997/98 ended on a sad note with the passing of our President of the last seven years and Life Member, Peter Aynsley. Peter was a highly respected umpire, committed to the betterment of cricket throughout the playing ranks in Blacktown and New South Wales. Peter gave countless hours training and supervising prospective umpires. He stood for many seasons in NSW grade matches and Blacktown District Representatives games. Peter will be sorely missed.

Our pre-season recruitment drive was extremely successful, more than 30 candidates attending our August course. Much of this success can be attributed to the media campaign in local newspapers, to whom we are very grateful. As a result of this our membership increased dramatically and the number of umpires officiating in each round of competition was double that of previous seasons.

As always, a full complement of umpires was provided for the District's Representative commitments. Local Semi-Finals and Finals series were well-fought and it was pleasing to see all matches, including juniors, had the services of an appointed umpire.

The Umpires' Association fully supports the District's requirement that coaches of junior teams hold a minimum level "O" Coaching Certificate. It is our aim to see this requirement extend to include compulsory attendance at an Umpiring Course and Field Day. The Examination Committee and members of the Executive are only too willing to be involved in any Club's coaching clinic (where all coaches, managers and captains should be in attendance) to give instruction on the Laws of cricket and local playing rules. MCC Law Books are always available for purchase through either myself or the Treasurer. More courses will be held next season, please watch your circulars for details.

Our Association exists to ensure that the laws of the game are followed in every match at which an umpire officiates. Clubs can request the appointment of an umpire to any match. This is done quite simply by telephoning the Secretary with at least 3 days notice; wherever possible these requests will be filled. Each umpire presents a report to the captain/coach/manager of each team he/she is umpiring, with a request that an assessment be given of the umpire's performance.

This feedback on performance is essential for our ongoing improvement of umpiring and playing standards in the District. It is in the Club's own interests to give as much constructive comment as possible on these reports - there may be a problem in the player's/umpire's interpretations of the laws which can then be clarified.

Our Annual Dinner was a quiet affair but much enjoyed by all in attendance.

On behalf of the Appointments Committee I would like to thank all those umpires who contributed to another successful season. It was gratifying to see our newly-qualified umpires playing such a large part in the local and representative matches. I hope to see you all back next year.

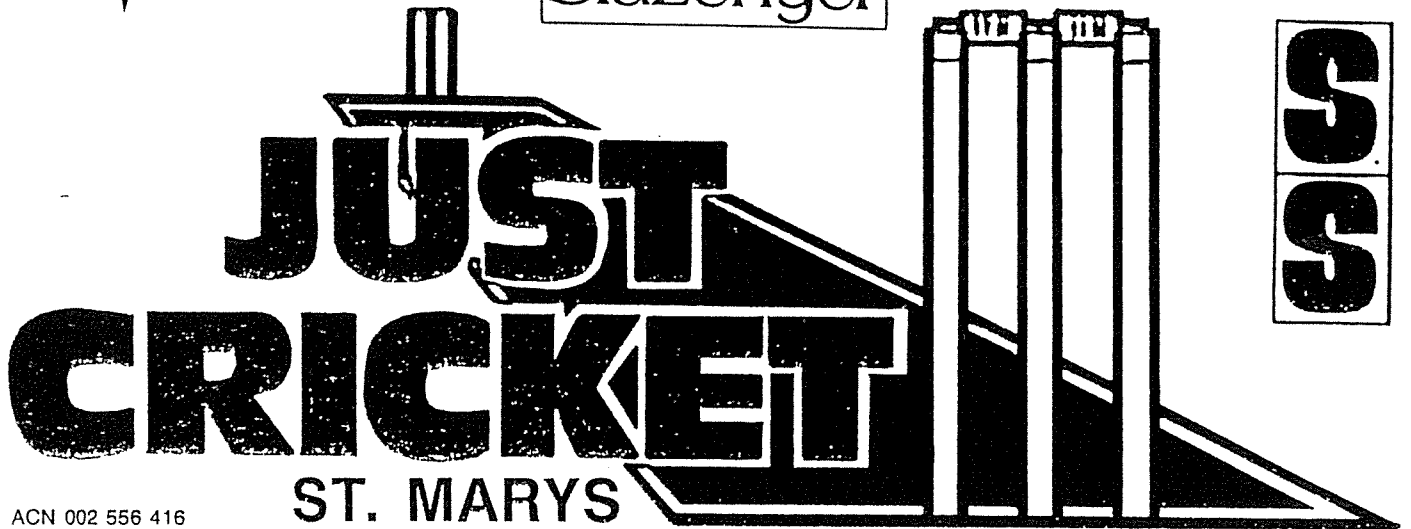

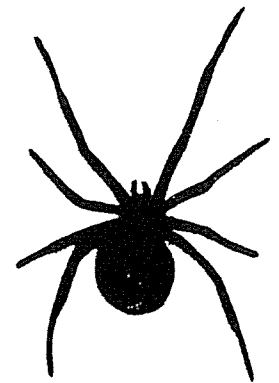
