In closing I would again like to congratulate all players, coaches and administrators for their efforts during the season and wish all a prosperous and enjoyable 1996/97 season.

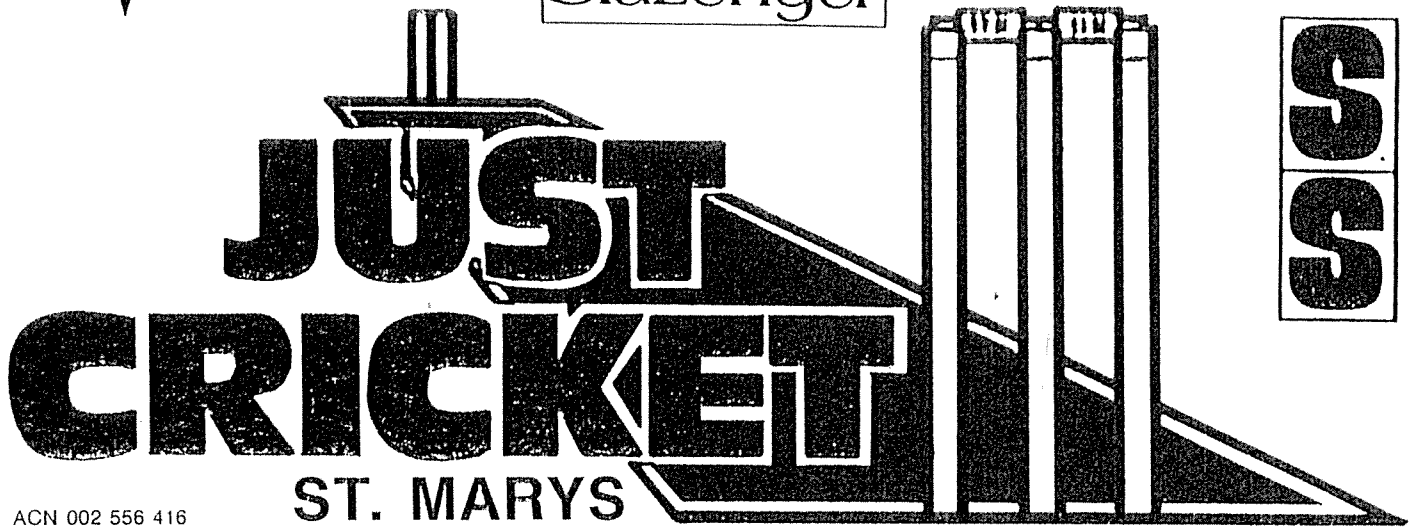

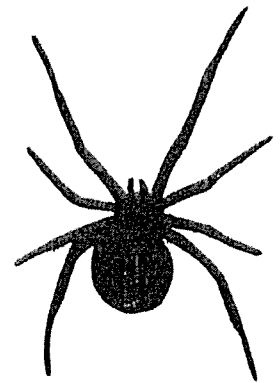

TREASURER'S REPORT

I would like to start this report with my grateful thanks to everyone out there in Cricketland for all your loving thoughts, prayers, telephone calls, cards, hospital visits and floral arrangements when I "threw my little dizzy" last year. Sorry about that folks but as you have since learnt, I'm a stubborn old so-and-so who just refuses to lie down. So here I am again right in the thick of it all.

Thank you to my very caring and long suffering family, particularly Garry and Kylie for all the T.L.C. and mostly for trying to understand why I wished to carry on with my work in the Association.

Thank you to my fellow Committee Members for all your usual consideration and affection which you have always shown me. Last year you excelled yourselves. No woman could have felt more protected and cherished than I did. Thanks guys.

Now onto cricket. Last season we lost one of our big sponsors - Metropolitan Credit Union. Considering that the previous season we lost another long standing sponsor - Insulco, it was a big loss. I'm afraid it is a sign of the times. Sponsorships are fast disappearing.

We are very fortunate to still have our old friends St. Marys Indoor Cricket Centre / Just Cricket. with us. They came to our rescue last season when M.C.U. pulled out by sponsoring an extra two teams. Thank you John and Greg.

We were again very fortunate this season by getting three new sponsors who each sponsored a Junior Rep. team. They were St. George Bank, Shell Oil Co. and Mt. Druitt Concrete. Thank you very much.

I can only try to impress on Clubs and their members to support our sponsors to the best of their ability.

At the A.G.M. a number of motions will be put forward relating to the need to increase Affiliation Fees for the forthcoming season. I look forward to the support of all Delegates in this important area and would argue that it is essential that the increases be approved. The Association has realised that reliance on our sponsorships is, at best, a year to year proposition.

The only opportunity we have of raising sufficient income to provide good competition within the District and develop our talented players through representative honours is to secure income through guaranteed sources.

A glimpse of our Balance Sheet for the past season will show that our Representative commitments outweighed our income from players subscriptions and sponsorships by nearly \$11,000. Indeed total expenses averaged about \$80 per player as against the \$20 player levy.

The Management Committee intends to redress that in a significant way in the new season, but still, a requirement is there for the Affiliation Fees to be raised.

In closing I would like to say I am very proud of what we have achieved in this District as I hope you all are. So let us stop sliding backwards and progress with enthusiasm and pride.
